Nurse Educator Graduate Certificate Candidates for the Nurse Educator Graduate Certificate must complete a total of 9 credit hours. Requirements include successful completion of NUR 412, 413, and 415. Admission Requirements for Nurse Educator Graduate Certificate All applicants to the Nurse Educator Certificate must show evidence of current enrollment in an accredited master's degree nursing program or evidence of graduation from an accredited master's degree nursing program. Applicants must meet general admission requirements as designated for the Mennonite College of Nursing Master of Science in Nursing program. In addition, the following documentation is required: (a) evidence of licensure as a registered nurse in Illinois; (b) completed Nurse Educator Graduate Certificate application form; and (c) reference form from a person qualified to assess the applicant's potential to succeed as a nurse educator. All materials for admission are to be forwarded directly to Mennonite College of Nursing (Campus Box 5810, Normal IL 61790-5810).

Since the inception of this program there has been a steep decline in demand for the certificate. We have had virtually no applications in the last three years and no students are presently enrolled.
