RE: Proposal to Delete the Minor in Chemistry for Teacher Education

The University Curriculum Committee has approved and is forwarding for Academic Senate review the attached Department of Chemistry proposal to delete the Minor in Chemistry for Teacher Education.

The Chemistry Department requests the deletion of the Minor in Chemistry for Teacher Education because it no longer plays a role in teacher certification. They suggest that a student wanting to take this minor program could take the regular minor and select CHE 301 as one of the optional courses. They also state that “elimination of the verbiage for the teacher education minor would remove the redundancy in the catalog.”

If approved by the Academic Senate the Minor in Chemistry for Teacher Education will be removed from the *2010-2012 Undergraduate Catalog*.
