The *Minor in Dance-Teacher Education Sequence* no longer accurately reflects the Teacher Certification requirement. Students wishing to receive an endorsement in Dance will achieve this through completing a series of specified coursework in the content area (24 hours) and passing the State Content Test. The suggested coursework for those seeking an endorsement in dance will be listed on the School of Theatre website, and not listed in the Undergraduate Catalog.

No effect- Previous students enrolled in the Minor in Dance-Teacher Education Sequence, were seeking an additional endorsement in this content area. The Secondary-Level Endorsement still exists (24 hours of coursework in the content area and passing the state content test).
