RE: Executive Summary – MAT Proposal for New Pedagogy Emphasis Sequence

The University Curriculum Committee approved and is forwarding for Academic Senate review the attached proposal from the Department of Mathematics to add a new Mathematics Pedagogy Emphasis Sequence.

The new sequence is being proposed as a result of a resolution from the Council for Teacher Education indicating that departments should select one of three paths as a contingency for students who are not successful in passing the edTPA mandated by the Illinois State Board of Education.

The new sequence will have the same requirements for completion as does the Mathematics Teacher Education Sequence in the Major in Mathematics, except successful completion of the edTPA requirement. The pedagogy emphasis option does not lead to licensure in the State of Illinois.

The University Curriculum Committee supports the proposal to add the new sequence.
