Dietetic Internship Sequence

Illinois State University offers an accredited Dietetic Internship program (21-month program) as a sequence in the M.S. in Family and Consumer Sciences. Thesis option is 33 hours, and the nonthesis option is 39 hours.

Option I—Thesis

Students selecting this 33-hour option will complete the follow degree requirements:

- 9 hour core: FCS 401, FCS 445, and FCS 497
- 11 hours: FCS 417, FCS 420, FCS 402 (2 hours, repeated for a total of 4 hours)
- 6 hours of Internship Rotations: FCS 498
- 3 hours of electives
- 4 hours: FCS 499

Option II—Non-Thesis

Students selecting this 39-hour option will complete the follow degree requirements:

- 9 hour core: FCS 401, FCS 445, and FCS 497
- 11 hours: FCS 417, FCS 420, FCS 402 (2 hours, repeated for a total of 4 hours)
- 6 hours of Internship Rotations: FCS 498
- 13 hours of electives

Successful completion of the master's degree requirements, in conjunction with the supervised practice experience, are required to earn the ACEND Verification Statement necessary for applying to take the national registration examination. The graduate dietetic internship (MS and Certificate program) at Illinois State University is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics, FCS 120 South Riverside Plaza, Suite 2190, Chicago IL 60606-6995; (312) 899-0040, ext. 5400.

This sequence is being deleted from the Family and Consumer Sciences Program and added to a new Masters in Nutrition program. A Master's degree in nutrition, rather than the more general Master's degree in Family and Consumer Sciences we have now, will be more visible to potential students and make graduates more competitive for jobs in their respective subfields within nutrition. Further, the Commission on Dietetic Registration is requiring a graduate degree for registered dietitians effective January 1, 2024.

4. Describe the expected effect of the proposed program deletion on existing campus programs.

We do not anticipate any effects on other programs as this sequence will still exist and in the same department. It is just moving programs.
