Interdisciplinary coursework in language skills development, linguistics, and literary and cultural studies; internships and community engagement; and study abroad opportunities will further develop students' language proficiency, intercultural communication abilities, and cultural knowledge. In the teacher education sequences, future world language teachers will take additional coursework and professional practice. Spanish students may pursue an accelerated sequence toward an MA. LCS majors go on to pursue careers in business, education, health and human services, law, translation and interpretation, and more. LCS is a flexible program that pairs well with other degree programs.

Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture Studies majors choose from sequences in French, German, or Spanish. The program develops advanced abilities in oral and written communication while cultivating an understanding of how human language operates within cultural, social, and historical contexts in the United States and around the world.

Students complete interdisciplinary coursework in language skills development, linguistics, and literary and cultural studies, complemented by internships, community engagement, and study abroad opportunities. Together, these experiences strengthen language proficiency, intercultural communication, and critical cultural awareness.

Students in teacher education sequences complete additional coursework and supervised professional practice to prepare for careers in world language education. Spanish students may pursue an accelerated pathway toward the MA.
